GLASGOW

Take a cycle ride through Glasgow's rich industrial past as you follow the historic waterways of the Forth and Clyde Canal to its terminus at picturesque Bowling Harbour, before returning along the industrialised banks of the River Clyde.

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

From George Square, head south to the Clyde Walkway and National Cycle Route 756. Follow this well-signed route through Kelvingrove Park and along the Kelvin Walkway to the Forth and Clyde Canal Towpath (NCN 754) at Kelvin Agueduct. Follow the towpath west passing the striking 'Bankie's Bike' sculpture by John Crosby, en route to picturesque Bowling Harbour.

Take a short detour onto 'The Bowline'—Scotland's answer to the New York High Line. This former railway viaduct is now a scenic linear park, offering panoramic views over the harbour and Firth of Clyde.

Retrace your route to 'Bankie's Bike' before following NCN 7 south and then east along the River Clyde. Enjoy sweeping river views as you pass historic landmarks like the Titan and Finnieston cranes, alongside modern architectural icons such as The Riverside Museum, S E C Armadillo, OVO Hydro, and the Tradeston 'Squiggly' Bridge.
